# **NEW PRELAK**

New formulation of the PreLak range making it better in its first use as a primer, with more acrylic helping to reduce side-bonding even more. The new formulation has a faster drying time than the previous PreLak which I'm sure you will all be happy to hear.

We decided that instead of bringing out lots of new lacquers like invisible lacquers or fast drying lacquer, that we would keep it simple and stick with our Good, Better & Best range of lacquers and focus on an area that could give more potential to you the end user – Primers

### **NORDIC**

White pigmented primer to give an invisible effect when coated with a Junckers Ultra Matt lacquer but on a lower price point. Use two coats to create a Driftwood White Effect (looked great on Pine, Beech & Oak)



### **DRIFTWOOD GREY**

A colour that is difficult to get right on softwood with oils, leading to messy stains – We created a grey that can be double coated to give more depth or indeed diluted to lighten



#### DARK COCO

Taken from our Dark Coco Oil, we quickly realised that this product has lots of potential when simply diluting by 25%, 50% or 75% with clear Prelak, we created a light, medium & dark oak floor with ease, fast drying and little mess.





## WHITE


The same strength as our previous white, but with the improved base and quicker drying

Our, New Strong lacquer has been upgraded – Polyurethane & Acrylic mix with the latest binder, this 1K product is the perfect all round Strong & durable lacquer

- Reformulated with binder changes
- Less sensitive
- Very hard lacquer
- Changed the name to 'Strong'

This product is really good, first and foremost it levels well and dries nicely.

When it comes to performance, this product is really tough for a midrange lacquer.

During testing we really pushed this product. It's surface strength even after one coat is surprising!

# NEW PLASTIC CONTAINERS

We will be changing our HP lacquer containers from metal cans to plastic screw-top cans. Junckers has always supplied these products in plastic cans to all other global markets and so the change is to enable us as a group to have consistency.

Many of you will know that plastic cans have been used for these products before. We know that some UK contractors had issues with mixing in the hardener effectively. We can reassure anyone with concerns that no issues have been encountered with continuing use of plastic cans in other countries.

The best mixing method is to decant the lacquer into a large bucket or similar container and to add the hardener slowly whilst stirring.


For those who prefer to add the hardener straight into the can it is important that the lacquer is first shaken thoroughly, the hardener added slowly and then shaken again or stirred straight away.

The mixture should always be left to stand for ten minutes before use.

The instructions on the label provide a little more detail.
